

#### CONSULTANT AGREEMENTS

#### **Construction Inspection Agreements**

- Almost \$6 Million in construction inspection agreements for 2024:
  - Project-Specific
    - I-79 Crawford Co: \$650K
    - SR 4034 Erie Co: \$280K
    - SR 531 Erie Co: \$765K
    - SR 6 Crawford Co: \$1.2M
  - Open-End
    - Two agreements at \$1M and \$2M

All agreements except the \$2M open-end are advertised as of this writing.




#### CONSULTANT AGREEMENTS

#### **Consultant Design Agreements**

- \$21.5 Million capacity for non-project specific open-end agreements
  - Shared between design and construction units
- Upcoming agreements:
  - \$2 Million open-end advertisement in February
  - \$1.5 Million open-end advertisement in March
  - Project-specific agreement for the next 2 phases of the I-80 reconstruction (Spring 2024 advertisement)
  - May have additional open-ends near the end of the year



#### CAPITAL FUNDING




- About \$138 Million in discretionary funding in 2021-25
  - Erie: \$116 Million
  - Mercer: \$8.5 Million
  - Northwest: \$13.1 Million



#### MAINTENANCE FUNDING

- \$125 Million moved from PA State Police to Motor License Fund in FY 2023 (statewide)
  - \$50M to construction
  - \$50M to highway maintenance
  - \$25M to capital equipment
- District 1 invests an average of \$14.7M in equipment annually
  - Includes purchase of some new equipment, plus maintenance, repair and fuel costs
  - Does not include purchase of new equipment by central office for D1






#### SR 318 BRIDGE STRIKE

- Bridge carrying SR 318 over I-376
  - SR 318 about 3,200 AADT; I-376 about 6,600 AADT
- Strike reported Dec 7, 2023 at 11AM
  - Roll-off dumpster truck with boom extended struck through the first two beams, damaged the third and pierced through the deck
- I-376 EB traffic detoured via ramps at SR 318 interchange
- I-376 EB reopened Dec 8 at 8PM (33 hours after initial incident)





#### SR 318 BRIDGE STRIKE



Assessment, emergency authorization and reopening of I-376 EB was done within 33 hours following the strike.








# MESSERALL TRUSS

- Restoration and rehabilitation planned for portions of the eastern half by 2030
- Four projects totaling over \$130 Million since 2019 (active and completed projects to date)



SR 215 Bridge Removal







#### BAYFRONT PARKWAY PROJECT

- \$111 Million construction contract
- Four construction phases spanning 2023-2027
- Features:
  - Two-lane roundabouts at Sassafras Street Extension and Holland Street
  - Grade-separated intersection at State Street
  - Sidewalk and crosswalk upgrades throughout
  - Multi-use trail connecting the existing trail network, downtown, and the waterfront
  - Overhead pedestrian bridge at Holland Street












#### MERCER, SR 62 RAILROAD TUNNEL




- Tunnel carrying SR 62 under Canadian National Railway in Coolspring, Mercer County
- Replacement of the structurally deficient tunnel and clearance increase to 16'-6"
- Railroad constraints:
  - Railroad detouring is not feasible
  - RR realignment would affect 8200'
  - RR closures limited to 1-2 days
  - At-grade crossing could be considered
- Estimated let in 2029



#### SR 6N UNDERPASS ERIE COUNTY






- Replacement of Bessemer/Lake Erie RR structure over Route 6N in Erie County
- Includes roadway widening and lowering profile to increase horizontal and vertical clearances
- Updates to drainage and guiderail
- Estimated let date: June 30, 2027



# LIBERTY STREET, FRANKLIN





TYPICAL SECTION - LOOKING EAST TOWARD 12TH ST

- 12<sup>th</sup> Street intersection improvements:
  - Flattening existing curve at the intersection
  - Add bump-outs to shorten pedestrian crossings
  - Improve signal visibility
  - Increase sight distance
  - New pavement markings
  - New signal location
- Liberty Street changes:
  - Single lane each direction
  - Painted center median
  - Dedicated bicycle lanes
    - Estimated let date: Dec 1, 2025
