

**“B.J. SMITH” COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM

POLICY GUIDELINES COVERING**

- The B.J. Smith Family Trust has provided the ASHE Franklin Section an opportunity to continue this B.J. Smith College Scholarship. The ASHE Franklin Section as requested by the Burnell J. And Loismarie C. Smith Revocable Trust set up an IRS qualification for exemption under IRS section 501(c)(6). The ASHE Franklin Section is teaming with the Crawford Heritage Community Foundation to continue to honor Mr.& Mrs. B.J. and Loismarie Smith in this request.
- The number and amount of scholarships will be determined by the ASHE Franklin Board and the Scholarship Committee annually. The scholarship(s) is(are) awarded annually to an applicant of good personal character who demonstrates satisfactory academic achievement.
- The recipient must be a son/daughter, stepson/stepdaughter or foster child of a member in good standing, of the Franklin Section of the American Society of Highway Engineers.
- The recipient must be a high school graduate or presently enrolled in college.
- A Scholarship Committee, comprised of at least three Section members, will evaluate all applications and determine the successful candidate.
- Scholastic achievement, application presentation, extra-curricular activities, community service, character and financial need will be considered by the Scholarship Committee.
- The scholarship will be granted only to applicants desiring to attend an educational institution on a full time basis. Any approved curriculum in an accredited college or university within the United States of America will be acceptable.
- A scholarship recipient who interrupts his/her studies during the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded shall forfeit any balance. Exceptions are military duty or medical reasons.
- No one person can receive a scholarship twice.
